**CITY SQUARE PARK  
MAINTENANCE**

Two members of the Chaska Public Works Department have been working on re-laying the pavers in City Square Park. Over the years the pavers have settled from the elements, pedestrians, and vehicles. Brad Henke and Kevin Lundquist began the job prior to River City Days. The first section of walkway on the southeast corner of the park was completed prior to the community event. They are now working on the northeast walkway.



Each section takes about a week and a half to complete. All the brick pavers are removed by hand and then cleaned. More sand is laid down, leveled, and compacted. The pavers are then re-laid and compacted down.

This is a massive task that will ultimately mitigate safety hazards and continue to enhance the park.
