

ELECTION JUDGE GENERAL INFORMATION

The City of Chaska will be conducting elections on August 10 and November 2, 2010. Election judges are needed to work at the polling locations to supervise and help with elections. If you are 18 years of age or older and an eligible voter, you may qualify to serve as an election judge.

Duties of the election judge include:

- Opening and closing of the polls
- Being responsible for all election materials
- Ensuring that only qualified voters are permitted to vote, are at the correct polling site, and that each voter is permitted to vote only once
- Registering new voters on election day
- Distributing ballots
- Tallying and certifying the election results

Election judges will be appointed in July by the City Council. Two to three hours of training is required. Judges are paid for training and working at the polling place.
