## Minnesota Department of Human Rights

As part of the "Educate to Eliminate Discrimination" mandate, the Minnesota Department of Human Rights (MDHR) organizes training for employers, public service providers and other businesses on the Minnesota Human Rights Act. These events are called "Training Showcases" and the MDHR strives to present subject matter experts who are knowledgeable in rights and responsibilities under the Act. This training increases knowledge about human rights, and civil rights in our state, as well as rights and responsibilities of employers in Minnesota.



A MDHR "Training Showcase" will be offered on **Thursday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>**, at the Chanhassen Carver County Library – Wilder Room – 7711 Kerber Blvd, Chanhassen. The training will take place from 8 AM – 12 PM.

The training agenda will cover:

- ADA requirements in the workplace.
- Preventing and Responding to Discrimination and/or Harassment Complaints.
- An examination of cases brought to the MDHR and a demonstration of how the complaint process works.
