Chaska Officers issued 49 citations and 24 warnings during this reporting period.
There were 221 calls for service

DWI:

A male showed signs of being intoxicated while inside a convenience store. He drove away from the store in his vehicle and a witness called the police. Officers responded and stopped the vehicle on Yellow Brick Road. The male was arrested and charged with DWI and driving without a license.

Disturbances:

During an altercation at a residence, one female assaulted another female, causing an injury. The victim was treated at a hospital and the female offender was charged with 3rd degree assault. Days later, the victim called police to report the offender and another female were harassing and threatening her, in reference to the assault. Officers located and arrested the two females. They were charged with witness tampering.



Police were called to a residence after family members discovered numerous drug-related items inside. The items belong to an adult male relative. The items tested positive for methamphetamine. Hash and THC were also found inside the home. The male offender was located and arrested for possession of a 5th degree controlled substance, possession of a small amount of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Two males were following and harassing another male, while he was walking in downtown Chaska. Police responded to the area and located the males in a business parking lot. One male, who was a minor, was intoxicated and provided a false name to police. He was charged with minor consumption of alcohol, possession of drug paraphernalia and providing false information to a police officer. He was placed in a detox facility.
