**Chaska Officers issued 39 citations and 23 warnings during this reporting period.
There were 233 calls for service**

Disturbances:



A vehicle was stopped for traffic violations on Creek Road. A male passenger in the vehicle was taken into custody on an arrest warrant. He was in possession of marijuana, drug pipes and a grinder. He was charged with possession of marijuana in a motor vehicle and possession of drug paraphernalia. The driver of the vehicle was cited for three traffic offenses.

A front entry door was removed from a parked S300 Bobcat and stolen. The Bobcat had been parked overnight in the Chaska Commons area.

A male was observed stumbling and tripping, while attempting to cross Yellow Brick Road near County Road 61. An officer stopped the man, who submitted to a breath test. The result was a .24 BAC. He was taken into custody and placed in a detox facility.

A male driver was stopped on County Road 10 after an officer learned he had six active arrest warrants. He was arrested and taken into custody for the warrants. Fourteen grams of marijuana was found in his vehicle. He was charged with possession of marijuana in motor vehicle and not having a driver's license.

Notable:

Drivers Education...

While on patrol, an officer performed a routine registration check on a vehicle, which had just passed him. The officer learned there were two registered owners for the vehicle, a female and male. The male, who was driving, had a suspended driver's license. The female, who was the passenger, had an active arrest warrant for theft. The officer followed the vehicle as it drove into and parked in a parking lot on Crosstown Blvd. The vehicle was parked for approximately five seconds before the occupants quickly exited the vehicle and spoke to the officer. The male driver told the officer he had already parked the vehicle and was not driving now, so the officer could not give him a ticket. The officer interpreted the law on driving after suspension differently from the male and issued a citation forthwith. The woman was arrested on the warrant and transported to jail.
