## Investigations Unit Receives New Camera

The Chaska Police Investigations Unit recently received a donation of two new Canon digital cameras from the Carver County Sexual Assault Interagency Council (SAIC). The ability to take quality crime scene photographs is vital for many investigations and photographic evidence can be critical for the successful investigation and prosecution of sexual assault reports. SAIC received grant funding to make this and other donations possible.



The Chaska Police Department is a long term SAIC member agency and supports the SAIC mission, "To ensure the coordination of a consistent, respectful, victim-centered response to sexual assault in Carver County". Participation in the SAIC also helps us to fulfill our mission, "Serve.Protect".



### *Around the Clock* *-Sgt. Ben Anderson*

**Chaska Officers issued 36 citations and 14 warnings during this reporting period.  
There were 207 calls for service**

#### **DWI:**

Officer Juell stopped a vehicle for tailgating and swerving in the lane of traffic on Audubon Road. A male driver and a male passenger occupied the vehicle. The driver was intoxicated and was arrested for DWI. While conducting an impound inventory search of the vehicle, officers located a large amount of marijuana and a scale. The marijuana was in two separate large bags. The males were arrested and charged with 5<sup>th</sup> degree sales, possession of marijuana in a motor vehicle, and possessing an open container of alcohol in a motor vehicle. The driver was additionally charged with 2<sup>nd</sup> degree DWI, underage possession of alcohol and driving after revocation. Both males are documented gang members.



Police received a report of a disorderly person at the Chaska VFW. Officers responded and stopped the male as he was attempting to drive out of the parking lot. He was intoxicated and was arrested for DWI.

#### **Disturbances:**

During an argument over computer use at their home, a juvenile male assaulted his stepfather. He punched his stepfather several times in the head during the altercation. Police arrived and arrested the male for domestic assault.



A husband and wife returned to their residence after consuming alcohol at numerous establishments. Upon entering their home, they became involved in an altercation. The husband pushed his wife onto the floor, then punched and kicked her. She fled the residence and checked into an emergency room a short time later. The hospital contacted the Chaska Police Department in reference to the assault. Officers located the husband at his residence later that morning. He was arrested and charged with domestic assault.



A male Chaska High School student became disruptive by refusing to go to class, when instructed to do so by school staff. The male became disrespectful, defiant and physically threatening toward staff and a school resource officer. He resisted arrest with force as officers took him into custody. He was transported to the juvenile detention center and was charged with obstructing the legal process with force.
