At 5:20 AM on Thursday, March 24th, officers responded to a Willow Street address for a 911 call indicating that a female was being assaulted. Officers heard screaming from inside and had to force their way into the residence. Officers arrested 42-year-old Jim Rogers (AKA: Arkinzie Eric Solomon), Minneapolis, for attempted Criminal Sexual Conduct, Kidnapping, and Terroristic Threats, all felony level crimes. Rogers was also arrested for an outstanding arrest warrant from Hennepin County for Failing to Register as a Predatory Offender.

To date the investigation has shown that Rogers and the adult victim knew each other. While visiting the victim, Rogers attempted to sexually assault her and threatened her life. Rogers also physically prevented the victim from fleeing the residence prior to the officers' arrival. The investigation is ongoing and Rogers is being held at the Carver County Jail pending his first court appearance on Monday, March 28th.
