Chaska Officers issued 15 citations and 24 warnings during this reporting period

DWI:
A female driver caused an accident when she rear-ended another vehicle on Pioneer Trail near the Chaska Commons. Her driver's license was revoked and she was intoxicated. She was arrested and charged with DWI and driving after revocation. Her vehicle is subject to forfeiture.

Officer McClure stopped a vehicle for numerous traffic violations in the area of Waters Edge Drive and Village Road. The male driver was intoxicated and was driving on a restricted drivers license. He was arrested for DWI and violating a restricted driver's license condition.



A vehicle failed to stop for a stop sign on Walnut Street. Sergeant Duzan stopped the vehicle and arrested the male driver for DWI. The driver was placed in a detox facility.

Disturbances:
