The JPA and required Resolution is mandated by the Minnesota Department of Public Safety (DPS) and the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension (BCA) to allow the Chaska Police Department (CPD) to share, have access to and exchange data.

This is a renewal of agreements already in place.
Without said agreements the DPS/BCA will not recognize CPD as an authorized/permitted user in their system.

CPD is further required to secure similar documents with the Carver County Attorney's Office and has done so.
