**RESOLUTION APPROVING STATE OF MINNESOTA JOINT POWERS AGREEMENTS  
WITH THE CITY OF Chaska ON BEHALF OF ITS CITY ATTORNEY AND POLICE  
DEPARTMENT**

---

**WHEREAS**, the City of Chaska on behalf of its Prosecuting Attorney and Police Department desires to enter into Joint Powers Agreements with the State of Minnesota, Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension to use systems and tools available over the State's criminal justice data communications network for which the City is eligible. The Joint Powers Agreements further provide the City with the ability to add, modify and delete connectivity, systems and tools over the five-year life of the agreement and obligates the City to pay the costs for the network connection.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of Chaska, Minnesota as follows:

1. That the State of Minnesota Joint Powers Agreements by and between the State of Minnesota acting through its Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension and the City of Chaska on behalf of its Prosecuting Attorney and Police Department, are hereby approved. Copies of the two Joint Powers Agreements are attached to this Resolution and made a part of it.
2. That the Chief of Police, Scott Knight or his or her successor, is designated the Authorized Representative for the Police Department. The Authorized Representative is also authorized to sign any subsequent amendment or agreement that may be required by the State of Minnesota to maintain the City's connection to the systems and tools offered by the State.

To assist the Authorized Representative with the administration of the agreement, Sona Schneck is appointed as the Authorized Representative's designee.

3. That the Carver County Attorney, Mark Metz, or his or her successor, is designated the Authorized Representative for the Prosecuting Attorney. The Authorized Representative is also authorized to sign any subsequent amendment or agreement that may be required by the State of Minnesota to maintain the City's connection to the systems and tools offered by the State.

To assist the Authorized Representative with the administration of the agreement, Peter Ivy is appointed as the Authorized Representative's designee.

4. That Mark Windschitl, the Mayor for the City of Chaska, and Denise Wetzel, the City Clerk, are authorized to sign the State of Minnesota Joint Powers Agreements.
